STEPS TO FOLLOW IF YOU HAVE THE FLU



STAY AT HOME

Avoid close contact including those that live with you.

GET REST & DRINK PLENTY OF WATER

It is important to avoid dehydration or fluid loss.

TAKE OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS

Over the counter medications can relieve any fever, headache, muscle aches, cough, runny nose, sore throat, or body aches. Be sure to read and follow instructions on the bottle.

TAKE PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION

If you are prescribed a medication by your healthcare provider, be sure to follow the prescription instructions exactly as directed.

INFLUENZA (COMMONLY KNOWN AS "THE FLU") IS A CONTAGIOUS RESPIRATORY VIRUS WITH SYMPTOMS THAT CAN RANGE FROM MILD TO SEVERE.

Symptoms can include: fever or feeling feverish, chills, fatigue or tiredness, muscle or body aches, headaches, sore throat, stuffy or runny nose, vomiting and diarrhea.
