
TITLE VI:



PROTECTING YOUR CIVIL RIGHT IS GOOD BUSINESS

It is our policy to ensure that no person in the United States of America shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any of our programs and activities.



Fulton County hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of all departments to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities.

Any person who believes they have been subject to unlawful discriminatory practices under Title VI has the right to file a formal complaint. Any such complaint must be filed in writing or in person with Fulton County Department of Diversity and Civil Rights Compliance at 141 Pryor Street, 5th Floor, Ste. 5042, Atlanta, Georgia 30303.

HOW TO FILE A TITLE VI COMPLAINT



You may file a signed, written complaint 180 days to the date of the alleged discrimination. The complaint should include:

- Your name, address, and telephone number.
- Name and address of the agency, institution or department you believe discriminated against you.
- How, why, and when you believe you were discriminated against. (Include as much specific, detailed information as possible about the alleged acts of discrimination and any other relevant information.)
- Names or any person, if known, who Fulton County's Title VI Coordinator may contact for clarity of your allegations.
